EASTER EXPLORED!

CENTURIES EARLIER

Details of Jesus' death and resurrection were predicted in the Old Testament, centuries before the events of Easter weekend took place. For example, the Psalms predicted He would be betrayed by a close friend, while Zechariah predicted He would die by crucifixion.

EASTER SUNDAY

Three days after His death Jesus rose from the dead, just as He had predicted.

When some of His followers visited His grave early in the morning they found that the stone had been rolled away and the tomb was empty. An angel announced, "He is not here, He is risen!"

Later in the morning Jesus made His first of many post-resurrection appearances, to one of His most faithful followers, Mary Magdalene.

"Christ died for our sins... and He was buried... and He rose again the third day... and He was seen..."

1 Corinthians 15:3-5

EASTER FRIDAY

Having been betrayed by Judas, who was one of His followers, Jesus was arrested and eventually presented to the crowds by the Roman Governor, Pontius Pilate. The Jewish religious leaders incited the people to call for His execution. Jesus was whipped, beaten, and spat upon, before carrying His own cross to a place called Calvary (or Golgotha).

Jesus hung on the cross for a total of 6 hours. For the final 3 hours, in total darkness, He suffered God's punishment for mankind's sin.

After His death, Jesus' body was taken and laid in a tomb.

THE SIGNIFICANCE

Through His death and resurrection Jesus has provided forgiveness of sins, eternal life, and a home in Heaven to everyone willing to turn from their sins and place trust in Him.

Community Kickabout!


PLAYERS WANTED! GET IN TOUCH IF YOU FANCY A GAME!
